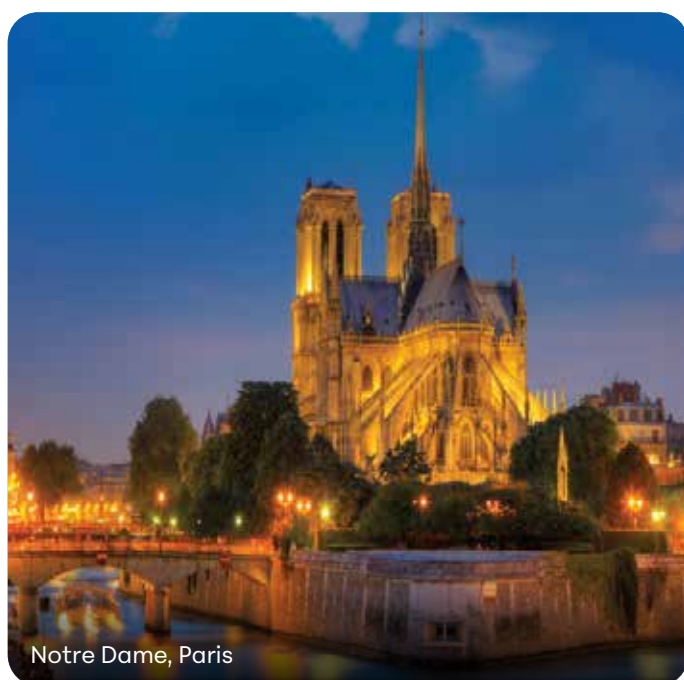

Follow the scent of gingerbread to the heart of the Old Town, where Rudesheim's enchanting Christmas market is in full swing. Be sure to stop by the famous Käthe Wohlfahrt Christmas store, where you'll find the perfect festive decorations and gifts. BLD

Day 5. Cochem Sit back and soak up the scenery as you cruise through some of Europe's prettiest stretches along the Moselle River. Disembark in the quaint town of Cochem in the Moselle

Valley. Explore the narrow alleyways lined with half-timbered houses and visit the magnificent Cochem Castle. Perched on a hill overlooking the beautiful Moselle River, this castle could be straight from the pages of a fairy tale. Cochem's Christmas market is just as idyllic as the town itself, which goes to great lengths to decorate festively and create seasonal flair for those who visit. BLD

Day 6. Cologne ★

Arrive in Germany's Cologne and be met by the magnificent Cologne Cathedral on the banks of the Rhine. Join a guided tour, learning about the famous twin spires of this landmark cathedral, which took over six centuries to complete. Then, be immersed in the festive spirit with a visit to Cologne's impressive Christmas market, backdropped by the iconic Kölner Dom Cathedral. Here, you'll have the chance to sample mulled wine and some local delicacies. Tonight, enjoy the Captain's Farewell Dinner on board. BLD

Day 7. Amsterdam Today you will board a glass-top boat and glide past Amsterdam's waterside sights with a local guide. Back on land, enjoy some free time to explore the city's Ice Village Christmas market at your leisure. Sample some traditional Dutch Christmas treats and marvel at the magical display of lights strung alongside the canals. BLD

Day 8. Price Validity

Prices in this brochure were correct at time of publication but are subject to change. The most up-to-date pricing will be found on our website – www.travelmarvel.com. Prices will be confirmed at time of booking and honoured for up to seven days. All holidays are subject to availability at the time of booking.

Credit and Debit Card Surcharges

If you pay Travelmarvel by credit or debit card, surcharges will apply. In the case of credit cards, a surcharge of between 1% and 3% (depending on the card used) is added to the tour price. In the case of debit cards, a charge of 0.7% is added to the tour price.

Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is not included in your holiday package. For peace of mind, we strongly recommend that you purchase appropriate fully comprehensive travel insurance suitable for your trip.

Airfares

Air travel is arranged with independent airlines. Travelmarvel will arrange air travel as advertised in connection with your holiday package. All airfares are subject to flight and class availability and will be booked on receipt of your deposit to avoid price or tax increases. Once air tickets are issued, amendment and cancellation fees and conditions apply and, in some cases, are non-refundable.

Transfers

Airport transfers are included on the first and last day of the holiday package and may be at designated times. They are not refundable if not used and cannot be re-routed. Other than the included transfer, all other transfers are at the travellers' own expense.

Enhance Your Journey

Minimum and maximum group numbers apply on some Enhance Your Journey tours. If your first choice is not available, you may be asked to choose an alternative.

Cancellation Policy
